

EXTERIOR DESIGN

What are the basic principles in exterior design?

External design depends on a set of basic principles that the designer or architect adheres to, which are:

Unity: It is the most important principle of exterior design because it includes placing design elements in one harmonious component that makes it look like one integrated element.

Proportion: consistency between design elements and the overall shape of the building, spaces and shapes.

Colors: Colors play a major role in the exterior design of a building, as they give it a bright, eye-catching appearance. By coordinating colors, the building can be made to appear larger or smaller as desired.

Balance: arranging the elements of exterior design in a balanced manner by merging shapes to give the building a striking and attractive appearance. Balance has types, the most important of which are:

Symmetrical: arranging exterior design elements in a harmonious manner.

Asymmetrical: Facade elements are arranged in an unorganized way, but it gives comfort to the eye and makes the building appear beautiful.

Radiant: Arranging elements on a circular curve so that they appear to emerge from a single point.

What are the types of exterior design?

The architect chooses the types of design that suit him and takes into account the aspirations of the building owner. Among the types of external design are:

Classic:

It is suitable for homes with large areas and large facades, and is distinguished by its elegance that appears through the arches and decorations.

It uses granite and marble stone painted in light colors such as white and yellow.

the talk:

It is based on simplicity and avoids decoration and complexity,

and is characterized by the possibility of applying it to all homes, regardless of their size. In addition to its beautiful geometric shapes and the use of modern cladding materials such as treated wood, metal and glass.

Contemporary:

This design is suitable for homes built in rural areas.

It is characterized by the design of unique geometric shapes and large spaces that give the architect room to develop new ideas and use different materials.
